BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

District staff are looking for input and assistance from the Board on the Fire Station 72 Project.

BACKGROUND:

The District is currently in the process of purchasing land for a new Fire Station 72. Staff have been working on a plan for constructing the new Fire Station 72. Several steps in the project would benefit from input and assistance from the Board.

DISCUSSION:

Staff are in the early stages of developing a plan for building a new Fire Station 72. Staff recognize that the formation of a Board Ad-Hoc committee to participate in the development of the new fire station would be beneficial during the process. Since an Ad-Hoc committee can be formed for a specific task or objective and usually meets as necessary to address specific issues, staff are asking for the Board to form an Ad-Hoc committee to work specifically on the Fire Station 72 Project. It is anticipated that the Fire Station 72 Project Ad-Hoc committee would be necessary for less than a year.

The Board can decide to not form a new Ad-Hoc committee for the Fire Station 72 Project.
