BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

Staff is asking the Board of Director's to authorize the Chief to dispose of surplus/ excess mobile equipment.

BACKGROUND:

In 2020, the Board approved the Mobile Equipment Replacement plan, at various times the Fire District needs to dispose of old or underutilized Mobile Equipment to reduce costs and maintain overall fleet size.

DISCUSSION:

The Fire District intends to dispose of the following vehicles/equipment through consignment with a recognized auction company:

1995 International 2674 Chassis(319), Vin#1HTGLAU32SH635463 (122,510 miles)
Utility Trailer (Service Body), CA 1120906
Old BS82 Service Body, No Chassis or CA Identification
2002 Freightliner FL106(234), Vin#1FVAB1B8X2HK93647 (183,868 miles)
1999 Freightliner FL106(235), Vin#1FV68HCB1XHA37155 (229,771 miles)
1985 International Brush(544), Vin#1HTLFTVN6FHA42125 (209,871 miles)

The Fire District intends to surplus the following vehicle and transfer it to the Mountain Valley Volunteer Fire Department (MVLFD). This vehicle transfer would occur as a component of the Fresno County MOU Extension of Services Agreement, Assistance to non-taxing Volunteer Fire Departments. Moreover, this vehicle transfer would satisfy the District's current Fiscal Year (FY) support for MVLFD.

2007 Chevy K2500HD (080), Vin#1GCHK29KX7E508132 (168,183 miles)

1. The Board votes not to approve all or part of the equipment disposal.
