NOTICE INVITING BIDS

The Fresno County Fire Protection District ("District") seeks bids from qualified contractors for Asphalt Replacement at the District's Fire Station 87 located at 4706 E. Drummond Ave, Fresno Ca, 93725 (the "Project").

The District will receive sealed bids at its Main Office at 210 S. Academy Sanger CA 93657 until **3:00 P.M.** on **Thursday October 31st, 2024**

Compliance With the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act: Owner shall accept bids only from qualified bidders that are currently registered with the District as pre-qualified contractors under the Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (Pub. Contract Code § 22000 *et seq.*,) with asphalt paving replacement expertise consistent with Public Contract Code Section 22034(a).

Required Onsite Visit: Owner will hold an onsite visit, tentatively scheduled for Thursday October 17th, 2024 at 9:00AM. Parties interested in submitting a bid should attend this visit and must RSVP to Louisa Alonzo via email (<u>louisa.alonzo@fire.ca.gov</u>) prior to the visit.

The District has a standard contract ("Contract Documents"), which shall be used for this Project, and which the successful bidder shall be required to execute. Bidders are responsible for performing their own assessments of the conditions of the Project site. Bidders may obtain the Contract Documents and additional information by contacting visiting the District website (www.fresnocountyfire.org).

Required Contractor Registration: Owner shall accept bids only from bidders that are currently registered and qualified to perform public work pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5.

Prevailing Wage Laws: The successful bidder must comply with all prevailing wage laws applicable to the Project, and related requirements contained in the Contract Documents. This Project is subject to prevailing wage compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

Reservation of Rights: Owner specifically reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to reject any or all bids, to re-bid, or to waive inconsequential defects in bidding not involving time, price or quality of the work. Owner may reject any and all bids and waive any minor irregularities in the bids.

Bid Preparation Cost: Bidders are solely responsible for the cost of preparing their bids.

Instructions to Bidders: Bids must include: 1) a total, lump-sum bid price for all work required to complete the Project; 2) proof of the bidder's registration with the Department of Industrial Relations; 3) contractor's license number(s); 4) a description of work experience; 5) a proposed Project schedule; and 6) proof of insurance required by the Contract Documents.

Lowest Bid: The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder based on the specifications noted in the bid.
