BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

Staff has just learned that the District has been approved and funded for the VFA grant for Fiscal Year 17/18. To execute the VFA Agreement the Board must adopt a Resolution authorizing the District Vice President to execute the Agreement between the District and the State of California, Department of Forestry and Fire Protection (CAL FIRE).

BACKGROUND:

The District has received the grant in the past and used the funds to purchase Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). The current year's budget included these grant funds to purchase PPE.

DISCUSSION:

Recently, the District was approved to receive the grant funds. This grant is a 50% reimbursement grant. The total of the grant is approximately \$40,000. Total reimbursement back to the District will be 50% of what was actually spent or approximately \$20,000. District staff plan to purchase structural PPE with this grant. Resolution 2018-01 is authorizing the District Vice President to execute the VFA Grant Agreement.

ALTERNATIVES:

- 1. The District could decide to not accept the grant.
- 2. The District could accept the grant and purchase needed PPE.

IMPACTS (Consider potential consequences related to each of the following areas of concern for proposed alternatives):

- Fiscal There is no impact to the budget since the District had planned on an additional \$40,000 in safety gear expenses. The District would be reimbursed up to 50% of what is actually spent or approximately \$20,000.00.
- Operational The PPE is needed to maintain serviceable PPE for operational personnel.

- Sociopolitical No known impact.
- □ Policy No known impact.
- Health and safety No known impact.
- ⊠ Environmental No known impact.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff is recommending the Board of Directors adopt Resolution 2018-01 and approves accepting the Volunteer Firefighter Assistance Grant for Fiscal Year 2017/2018. That any Board of Director makes a motion to adopt Resolution 2018-01 and accept the Volunteer Firefighter Assistance Grant.
