



JOB DESCRIPTION

PAID-CALL FIREFIGHTER

A Paid-Call Firefighter (PCF) position is to provide a cadre of well-trained part-time firefighters to respond to fires and other emergency calls for service within the Fire District. PCF's are community based and either live or work within the area they serve. A PCF Firefighter may report directly to a PCF Company Officer, PCF Fire Apparatus Operator or CAL FIRE career staff, as appropriate, under emergency and non-emergency conditions.

Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Respond to emergency calls within the initial response area of a given PCF company.
2. Perform the arduous duties of a firefighter, utilizing specialized equipment associated with responding to structural and wildland fires, vehicle accidents, rescues and medical aid emergency calls.
3. Maintain minimum certifications and qualifications as established by State, Federal and Fire District policy.
4. Meet the Fire District's established minimum criteria for responding to 50% of emergency responses and training 70% of scheduled training.
5. Maintain a valid California Driver's License.
6. Maintain a DMV driving record in accordance with Fire District policy.
7. Assist in training other PCF Company members.
8. Clean fire apparatus and maintain small tools and equipment.
9. Clean and maintain fire station buildings and grounds and perform general housekeeping duties.
10. Participate in company drills and attend specialized training sessions, as directed by his/her immediate supervisor.
11. Operate Fire District owned and operated vehicles during non-emergency conditions when licensed and authorized.
12. Assist with Fire Prevention and Education programs.
13. Follow the established chain-of-command.
