1. Chief Hail advised Ladder 72 was put into service and had a ceremony at Table Mountain Rancheria. A lot of representation from unit and Table Mountain and positive words from the Table Counsel.
2. Chief Hail advised incidents have slowed down due to weather and all resources are back in the unit.
3. AO Chrisman for Station 72, RFP's have been issued to the 3 (three) short listed. There will be a Meeting next week and includes a site visit.
4. AO Chrisman advised Fresno City has agreed to pay their outstanding balances for their transition agreement.
5. AO Chrisman gave an update on the generator grant. We have received 14 out of the 15 generators and transfer switches.
6. AC Bump advised Station 89 landscape is done. Station 96 windows are on order. Station 95 exterior doors have been ordered.
7. AC Bump, Station 74 pouring the pad for the first generator to be installed. Permits have been pulled for Stations 74, 75 ,77, 90 and 83. Station 89 is at the engineers.
8. AC Bump advised the PG&E component is delayed because need to replace panels, that are outside the security gates for Stations 83 and 89.
9. AC Michaels advised CAL FIRE resources have been moving up and down the state, so we up staffed our ABH resources.
- 10.AC Michaels advised Jeremiah Wittwer has moved into a division spot and Johnny Dominguez has been identified as the new Battalion 18.
- 11.BC Dominguez attending events in different communities, National night out, and farmers market in Fowler and football games. In addition, will be attending the Big Fresno Fair with our educational trailer.
- 12.BC Cosentino advised the well is working out, we have an adequate water supply. The fire pump was tested today and got the final today from our fire protection. Tomorrow, we have orientation for what was known as our basic fire academy that starts October 3. In addition, training is gearing up for all the training that is required for all the new hires coming into the unit.
- 13.Chief Hail advised did some reorganization with some positions. Jeremiah Wittwer will be D4304 position and will oversee the Shop, Training Center and Aviation with drones.
- 14.Chief Hail advised had a significant incident with a powerplant in Shaver. It's a mile and half hydroelectric plant and it had a transformer that exploded. There were 12 to 8 victims with smoke inhalation and will take them over a year to rebuild.

RESOLUTION No. 2022-18

IN THE MATTER OF:

A RESOLUTION OF THE FRESNO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY EXISTS, RATIFYING THE PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY BY GOVERNOR NEWSOM ON MARCH 4, 2020, AND AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODIES OF THE FRESNO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD OCTOBER 22, 2022 THROUGH NOVEMBER 21, 2022 PURSUANT TO BROWN ACT PROVISIONS.

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Fire Protection District (“District”) is committed to preserving and facilitating public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Directors (“Board”); and

WHEREAS, all meetings of the District’s legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code 54950 – 54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch the District’s legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by conditions as described in Government Code section 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the jurisdictions that are within the District’s boundaries, caused by natural, technological, or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, that proclamation also requires that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, or, the legislative body meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, such emergency conditions now exist in the District, specifically, a State of Emergency has been proclaimed by Governor Newsom on March 4, 2020, proclaiming a State of Emergency to exist in California as a result of the threat of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, during the COVID-19 pandemic, the District Board has conducted remote, teleconferenced meetings consistent with the Governor's Executive Orders promoting social distancing;

WHEREAS, consistent with AB 361, as a condition of extending the use of the provisions found in section 54953(e), the District Board must reconsider the circumstance of the state of emergency that exists in the District; and the District Board has done so;

WHEREAS, due to the surging Delta and Omicron BA.5 Variant of COVID-19, meetings in person would present imminent risk to health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, the District Board does hereby find that the State of Emergency proclaimed by Governor Newsom on March 4, 2020, **AND**, the Delta Variant of COVID-19 surging in Fresno County per the Fresno County Public Health Notice on August 20, 2021 followed by the Omicron Variant of COVID-19 has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the District that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the District, and desires to proclaim a local emergency exists and ratify the Proclamation of State of Emergency by the Governor of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency, the District Board does hereby find that the District legislative bodies shall conduct their meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, and that such legislative bodies shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953; and

WHEREAS, The District is providing teleconference access via a conference phone-line number to the meetings to ensure public access.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE FRESNO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. Affirmation that Local Emergency Exists. The District Board hereby proclaims that a local emergency now exists throughout the District, and the surging Delta and Omicron BA.5 Variant of COVID-19 would present an imminent risk to meeting in person.

Section 3. Ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency. The District Board hereby ratifies the Governor of the State of California's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of March 4, 2020.

Section 4. Remote Teleconference Meetings. The staff and legislative bodies of the District are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and

purpose of this Resolution including, conducting open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

Section 5. Effective Date of Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be effective until November 21, 2022, or such time the District Board adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to extend the time during which the District legislative bodies may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953.

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, dated this 3rd day of October 2022, by and between BVI CONSTRUCTION, Inc., whose place of business is located at 5111 E. Dakota Ave., Suite 102, Fresno, CA 93727 ("Contractor"), and the FRESNO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT (hereinafter "Owner"), acting under and by virtue of the authority vested in Owner by the laws of the State of California.

The Contract Sum includes all Work described in the Contract Documents and all costs related to the impacts from COVID-19 and local, County, and State requirements related thereto.
3. **COMMENCEMENT AND COMPLETION**
 - 3.01 **Commencement of the Work.** Contractor shall commence Work on the date stated in the Notice to Proceed (the "**Commencement Date**"). Owner reserves the right to modify or alter the Commencement Date.
 - 3.02 **Completion of the Work.** The Work shall be performed in a single phase. Contractor shall achieve Final Completion within 270 Calendar Days from the date when the Contract Time commences to run.
4. **PROJECT REPRESENTATIVES**
 - 4.01 **Owner's Project Manager.** Owner has designated Fire Chief, Dustin Hail as its Project Manager to act as Owner's Representative in all matters relating to the Contract Documents. Owner's Project Manager shall have final authority over all matters pertaining to the Contract Documents and shall have sole authority to modify the Contract Documents on behalf of Owner, to accept work, and to make decisions or actions binding on Owner, and shall have sole signature authority on behalf of Owner. Owner may assign all or part of the Project Manager's rights, responsibilities and duties to a Construction Manager, or other Owner Representative.
 - 4.02 **Contractor's Project Manager.** Contractor has designated Ken Grey as its Project Manager to act as Contractor's Representative in all matters relating to the Contract Documents.
5. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES**
 - 5.01 **Liquidated Damages for Delay to Substantial Completion.** As liquidated damages for delay, Contractor shall pay Owner three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) for each Calendar Day that expires after the time specified herein for Contractor to achieve Substantial Completion of the Work, until achieved.

- 5.02 Liquidated Damages for Delay to Final Completion.** As liquidated damages for delay, Contractor shall pay Owner one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for each Day that expires after the time specified herein for Contractor to achieve Final Completion of the entire Work, until achieved.
- 5.03 Scope of Liquidated Damages.** The liquidated damages amounts stated in Section 5.01 and 5.02 shall apply cumulatively. Limitations and stipulations regarding liquidated damages (if any) are set forth in Document 00 7200 (General Conditions).

- 7.02** It is understood and agreed that in no instance are the persons signing this Agreement for or on behalf of Owner or acting as an employee, agent, or representative of Owner, liable on this Agreement or any of the Contract Documents, or upon any warranty of

authority, or otherwise, and it is further understood and agreed that liability of Owner is limited and confined to such liability as authorized or imposed by the Contract Documents or applicable law.

- 7.03** In entering into a public works contract or a subcontract to supply goods, services or materials pursuant to a public works contract, Contractor or Subcontractor offers and agrees to assign to the awarding body all rights, title and interest in and to all causes of action it may have under Section 4 of the Clayton Act (15 U.S.C. §15) or under the Cartwright Act (Chapter 2 (commencing with §16700) of Part 2 of Division 7 of the Business and Professions Code), arising from purchases of goods, services or materials pursuant to the public works contract or the subcontract. This assignment shall be made and become effective at the time Owner tenders final payment to Contractor, without further acknowledgment by the parties.

- 7.05** During the term of this Agreement, Contractor warrants that it is currently registered with the Department of Industrial Relations and qualified to perform public work consistent with Labor Code section 1725.5. Contractor further warrants that any subcontractors who are subject to Public Contract Code Section 4104, are registered and qualified to perform public work consistent with California Labor Code Section 1725.5.
- 7.06** This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
- 7.07** This Agreement and the Contract Documents shall be deemed to have been entered into in the County of Fresno, State of California, and governed in all respects by California law (excluding choice of law rules). The exclusive venue for all disputes or litigation hereunder shall be in the Superior Court for the County of Fresno.

BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

There is a new Administrative Assistant vacancy at Headquarters. This position has been a Schedule A funded position in the recent past. Staff is recommending adjusting from Schedule A funding to Schedule C funding before filling the new vacancy. This will not impact the total number of personnel within this classification. Staff is also asking to update the wage range for the Administrative Assistant position related to the California minimum wage increases.

BACKGROUND:

The District Board authorizes the type and number of positions that are hired within the District. The District identifies positions that are either funded through the CAL FIRE Schedule A Program or through the District Schedule C Program. Where appropriate the District identifies the positions in both programs to allow for hiring flexibility (i.e. GIS Analyst, Staff Accountant and Heavy Equipment Mechanic). Regardless of the funding source, the number of positions is limited to the approved number of positions in Policy 1007, Personnel Positions.

Due to the enactment of [Senate Bill \(SB\) 3](#), the California minimum wage will increase to \$15.00 per hour, effective January 1, 2022, for employers with 26 or more employees, and to \$14.00 per hour for employers with 25 or fewer employees. Our current salary range for an Administrative Assistant is \$15.00 to \$19.14 (see Current policy 1007). We currently have 27 employees.

DISCUSSION:

Staff has identified the need to hire one Administrative Assistant behind a new vacancy. The Administrative Assistant will have the same responsibilities and duties as the current Schedule A Office Technician position that has become vacant. Staff is also recommending adjusting the associated salary range for Administrative Assistants from the current \$15.00 - \$19.14 per hour to \$20.00 - \$24.31 per hour. We currently have one other Administrative Assistant that would be impacted by this salary increase. This change would result in a wage increase of approximately \$3,860 annually for the current position if they are placed in the second wage step. However, by adjusting the hiring technique from Schedule A to Schedule C we would see an overall savings. The total wage and benefits package for the Schedule A funded position is \$95,395. The total wage and benefits package for Schedule C funded position at the first wage step with the proposed salary increase is approximately \$58,796. This adjustment will result in a savings of approximately \$36,599.

Staff will seek to hire the Administravtive Assistant postion as soon as possible.

ALTERNATIVES:

1. Make no changes at this time.
2. Propose developing a different wage range than proposed.

- Operational – Flexibility in hiring techniques

RECOMMENDATION:

It is also recommended that any Board Member makes a motion to approve Policy 1004, Schedule C Employee Salary and Wage Ranges and Policy 1007, Personnel Positions as presented. It is also recommended that any Board Member make a motion to allow the Chief or his Designee to move forward with the hiring process for an Administrative Assistant.
