BOARD OF DIRECTOR'S BRIEFING PAPER

ISSUE:

District staff are ready to issue a Request for Statement of Qualifications from Design-Build Entities for the Fire Station 72 Project.

BACKGROUND:

The Board's Fire Station 72 committee has meet and discussed the scope and timing of the project. The committee also reviewed several project delivery system options including Construction Management at Risk, Design-Bid-Build and Design-Build.

DISCUSSION:

The committee and staff are recommending the Design-Build project delivery system for the Fire Station 72 Project. The Design-Build method is a two-step process. The first step is the Request for Statement of Qualifications from Design-Build Entities. The Second step is the Request for Proposals from selected Design-Build Entities.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board can decide to not issue a Request for Statement of Qualifications for the Fire Station 72 Project.
